## ORGANIZATION

The International Association of Operative Plasterers' & Cement Masons was organized in 1864.

## NATURE OF TRADE

Smooths and finishes surfaces of poured concrete floors, walls, sidewalks, and curbs to specified textures, using handtools, which include floats, trowels, and screens. Spreads concrete to specified depth and workable consistency, using float to bring water to surface and produce soft topping. Levels, smooths and shapes surfaces of freshly poured concrete, using straightedge and float power screen. Finishes concrete surfaces, using power trowel, or wets and rubs concrete with abrasive stone to impart finish. Removes rough or defective spots from concrete surfaces using power grinder or chisel and hammer, and patches holes with fresh concrete or epoxy compound. Molds expansion joints and edges using tools, jointers and straightedge.
